THE FIRST SALE OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT TO CIVIC AND MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS BUREAU OF MACAU

This announcement is made by Freetech Road Recycling Technology (Holdings) Limited (the “**Company**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and the Inside Information Provisions under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571, Laws of Hong Kong).

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of the Company is pleased to announce that on 28 November 2016, Freetech Road Maintenance Engineering Co., Limited (“**Freetech Engineering**”), an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, through entering into a sale and purchase agreement (the “**Agreement**”) with an independent third party, sold asphalt pavement maintenance (“**APM**”) equipment to Civic and Municipal Affairs Bureau (“**Macau Bureau**”) of the Macau Special Administrative Region of the People’s Republic of China (“**Macau**”). Pursuant to the Agreement, Freetech Engineering will deliver the APM equipment to Macau Bureau in the first quarter of 2017. This is the first sale of APM equipment to Macau Bureau successfully achieved by Freetech Engineering. As the roads in Macau are narrow, the directors of the Company believe that the introduction of the Company’s high flexibility and customised APM equipment to Macau Bureau could reduce the traffic disturbance when performing road maintenance work in Macau.

Information of Civic and Municipal Affairs Bureau of Macau

Macau Bureau is the Macau government department responsible for executing specified tasks according to the law in the scope of city planning, and participating in city planning and road traffic regulation efforts in Macau.

The Company will continue to seek more opportunities to expand its overseas business.
